SUMMARY OF MEETING: Several annual reports were placed on file, including the Land/Cash report, and the annual Zoning report. A brief discussion of the Annual Priority Places Workshop, this year to discuss water supply. Filed the December 2006 Monthly Permit and Fee Report. Discussed and approved contracting to supply Permit and Inspection Services for the Village of Kaneville as they have with other villages in the past. They also discussed an amendment to the Schedule of Fees for the Kane County Storm water Ordinance. Discussed and passed on a resolution to expend \$ 200,000 on wetland restoration located on the Sauer Family Forest Preserve. This is supposedly money from a grant, but I am unclear who the grant was from.

MOST CRITICAL ISSUES(S): In my opinion , the most important issue here is the future workshop on water supply. The current schedule is for September 20, 2007 at the Q Center in St Charles. The board members were advised to reserve for this meeting early as space could be limited even though the room has a capacity of between 400 and 500. They expect many municipal and other community leaders to attend. I will contact the County Chairman's office about space for ordinary people.

COMMENTS/NOTES: Two county staffers who normally attend this meeting were missing : Phil Bus and Ken Shepro.
