DID PRESS COVER SIGNIFICANT ISSUES: Daily Herald covered animal control

SUMMARY OF MEETING: This meeting was largely routine. According to those reporting, the finances are good and everything is appropriate. Revenue is actually ahead of schedule. K-Chain is the only overage as some funding was pushed from '06 to '07. Animal control reported one rabid bat found and one person in Kane County with West Nile Virus. West Nile Virus has been less of an issue this year. Kane County and Kendall County have established an intergovernmental agreement to provide medical services in Kane County for Kendall County Tuberculosis Sanitarium Board. Kendall County will reimburse Kane County on a fee per service basis.

MOST CRITICAL ISSUES(S): Kane County Animal Control has increased adoptions from the facility since they have registered adoptable pets with petfinder.com. Illinois will be the 22<sup>nd</sup> state to go smoke-free, as of January 1, 2008.

RECOMMENDED ACTION(S): Monitor effects of no-smoking in public places in Kane County.
