SUMMARY OF MEETING: Reports given on Finance, Maintenance, Planning and Programming, Permitting, and Project Implementation. \$1.3 million has been collected from impact fees as of January 2007. Passed resolutions for approving 1) a wetland mitigation agreement for Kirk and Route 38; 2) an engineering agreement with Civil Engineering Serv., Inc. for on call general stormwater engineering assistance; 3) purchase of an articulating boom; an agreement with St. Charles Township road district for improvements at Randall and Red Gate; 4) construction replacing roads over three creeks and crack sealing; 5) speed limit alterations in three residential areas at the request of the township road districts; 6) purchase of traffic sign materials. The Settler's Hill temporary stoplight on Fabyan was extended for two years until the location of a permanent public entrance is decided.

The public meeting ended after a half hour and went into Executive Session. The agenda stated this was so they could decide land acquisition.

MOST CRITICAL ISSUES(S): Public hearing on Road Improvement Impact Fee will be on April 11.

Land is being acquired for Stearns Road bridge. The process will take several years.
